FIELD SEASON COMMENCES AT TMT PROJECT, ARGENTINA MT/IP Surveys to Refine Drill Targets

KEY HIGHLIGHTS

- **Exploration activities are now underway,** with road clearing progressing smoothly to the TMT camp and nearby Toro South target.
- MT/IP geophysical surveys are set to begin in the coming fortnight across the Toro South and Tambo South prospects, aiming to further refine high-priority targets in preparation for a drilling campaign planned for Q4 CY25.
- Quantec Geoscience, a recognised global leader in geophysical subsurface imaging, has been secured to conduct the geophysical surveys.
- **Drilling contract discussions with a leading international contractor are in the final stages**, with drilling expected to commence in late November 2025.

Belararox Limited (ASX: BRX) (Belararox or the Company) is pleased to announce an update on its highly prospective Toro-Malambo-Tambo (TMT) Project in Argentina's San Juan Province.

Managing Director Arvind Misra commented: "I'm very pleased with the strong progress by our Argentinian subsidiary GWK in finalising key contracts that pave the way for the next phase of exploration at the TMT Project. With lighter snowfall this year and no need for new road construction, field activities are on track to meet our timelines. Located in one of the hottest copper-gold exploration belts globally, TMT is advancing with leading partners like Quantec Geoscience, ensuring world-class execution as Belararox builds momentum toward unlocking the TMT's full potential."

Exploration Manager (TMT) Chris Blaser commented, "The field season is now underway at our TMT project, and we are moving full steam ahead. Once the access road is cleared and the Exploration camp is reopened, we will advance our exciting Toro South and Tambo South targets with combined MT/IP geophysical surveys. This program is designed to further refine our targets for potential follow-up drilling in Q4 CY25."

Site preparation and earthworks are underway in Belararox's TMT project to reopen the Exploration camp for the upcoming field season. No new road work will be necessary, only the clearing of existing tracks to the TMT camp and the Toro South and Tambo South high-priority targets.

Exploration activities will include the commencement of combined magnetotellurics (MT) and induced polarisation (IP) geophysical surveys at the Company's highest-ranking targets at Toro South and Tambo South, where assay results and 3D geochemical modelling have confirmed the presence of copper porphyry targets (refer to BRX ASX release on 23 September 2025).

MT/IP surveys can image zones of low resistivity from the surface to depths of over 2,000m and will be instrumental to further characterise the most prospective zones for follow-up drill targeting. Areas of Cu porphyry mineralisation typically coincide with low MT resistivity anomalies and have been successfully used in Cu porphyry projects elsewhere for refined drill hole targeting. Quantec Geoscience, a recognised global leader in geophysical subsurface imaging, has been secured to conduct the geophysical surveys.

The drilling contract negotiations are well advanced, and a binding agreement is expected to be executed shortly with a leading international contractor.




Figure 2 – Picture taken from the TMT camp at 3300m altitude, looking south towards the Toro South target approximately. 1km away. No new road work will be necessary, only clearing of existing tracks.

COMPETENT PERSON STATEMENT (TMT PROJECT ARGENTINA)
